

Golf courses operated by the City of St. Petersburg are **OPEN** to the public. For the health and safety of patrons and staff, the golf courses have implemented the following procedures to help reduce the spread of COVID-19:

- Patrons and employees are **required** to wear face coverings while in the Pro Shop.
- All golf courses will only accept credit and debit cards; **NO cash**.
- Golf cart rentals will be limited to one golfer per cart unless the golfers live in the same household or traveled to the golf course in the same vehicle.
- Hands-free golf ball retriever systems have been installed on flagsticks at all three golf courses.
- Equipment from the golf course including bunker rakes, ball washers and sand shovels have been removed to minimize touch points.
- Plexiglass shields have been installed at Point of Sale terminals.
- Golf carts are cleaned and sanitized after each use.
- Routine cleaning of clubhouse is being performed throughout each day.
- Physical distancing of 6 feet is required in all areas on the golf course.
- The number of customers allowed inside the Pro Shop is limited.
